Sub- Geo-Tagging Targets set by Ministry of Rural Development, GOI

Madam/Sir,

We have been talking of Geo-tagging of Assets for quite some time. In all our instructions, all the districts were requested Geo-Tag at the rate of 5 GP per day. We have been barely able to achieve the target assigned to the State for Geo-tagging of Assets in the WAVE-I districts by the end of November 2016. From December 2016, the Central Government has again given us targets for the next 2 months, in relation to reflection of accepted geo-tag points.

Considering the present scenario and the target given to us to achieve by **31st January 2017**, we have now decided to go by the policy of **Minimum Two Accepted Geo-Tagged points for each GP per day** for the rest of 43 days for the coming 2 months. Accordingly, the district wise targets for Geo-Tagging for the remaining 43 days have been indicated in the annexed excel sheet.

Kindly follow this regime and ensure that all the GPS under your jurisdiction are on track, even if some of the GPs failed to achieve the daily targets, you must ensure that overall target of the district is achieved on a daily basis. While tagging assets, the issue of quality may kindly not be lost sight.
