Sub: Performance in MGNREGA

Dear Mr./ Ms.

I would like to congratulate you and the members of your team at different level for the spectacular achievement in MGNREGA implementation during 2012-13. Concerted effort from the districts could result in surpassing the Labour Budget target of 18.33 Crore and achieve more that 20 Crore in terms of person-days generated.

However, I am extremely concerned over the slow pace of implementation of MGNREGA in the current financial year. Our high level of performance last year helped us obtain a high Labour Budget for 2013-14. However, flow of Government of India fund is subject to achieving month-wise Labour Budget projections. Till June, 2013 we are supposed to generate 3.36 Crore person-days whereas our data as reflected in the MIS as of today indicate a little over 1 Crore person-day generation which is far below the target mutually agreed at with the Government of India. You are certainly aware of the fact that the model code of conduct for the Panchayat General Elections does not affect implementation of MGNREGS works in the approved Annual Action Plan of the district. This being a rights-based targeted intervention for the poor, I would like you to ensure that the pace of implementation of the programme is not affected by involvement of your team in preparations for the Panchayat General Elections. Please take all possible steps to speed up implementation of the programme so that we can report person-day generation to the Government of India as per the mutually agreed Labour Budget. A detailed letter in this respect has been sent to you by the Commissioner, MGNREGS [Memo. No. 3820(20)-RD/P/NREGA/18S-01/08 dated 19-06-2013] which may be appropriately followed up at the level of the district and down below. I shall personally review performance of the districts in MGNREGA immediately after the Panchayat General Elections and it is expected that in the review meeting you will be able to report substantial progress.
